

# Take Caltrain to 100<sup>th</sup> Bay to Breakers

Caltrain will be running special train service to the Bay to Breakers race in San Francisco **Sunday, May 15**. Four northbound special limited trains will be available to take you to the race. Please refer to the timetable below for times and stations.

In addition to the Sunday regular service, two additional post-race express trains to San Carlos will depart from the San Francisco station at 1:10 p.m. and 2:10 p.m.

One-way tickets or Day passes can be purchased at the ticket vending machines at the stations before boarding. Customers using their Clipper<sup>SM</sup> card must remember to tag on before boarding and tag off at San Francisco. Caltrain is a Proof-of-Payment system. Customers without tickets are subject to citation or denied to continue their trip.

For your convenience, discounted train tickets are available by advance purchase for groups of 25 or more. Save 15 percent over single-ride tickets.
